

OFF-PEAK AND WEEKENDS

- Shuttle 404 from Deux-Montagnes to Downtown terminal (±1 h 05 min from 5 to 6:45 a.m.) (±50 min from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and from 6:45 p.m. to 12:15 a.m.)

EXPRESS BUS SHUTTLE - OPTIONS



RUSH HOURS (WEEKDAYS)

- Shuttle 405 between Deux-Montagnes and Sainte-Thérèse
 - ightarrow Four departures in each direction at morning rush hours;
 - → Four departures in each direction at the afternoon rush hours.



IMPROVED SERVICE1

Toward the Côte-Vertu station

- Line 144 from Sainte-Dorothée to the Côte-Vertu station (±45 min)

- Line 151 from Sainte-Rose to the Côte-Vertu station (±55 min)

- Line 902 between the Le Carrefour terminal and the Côte-Vertu station (±40 min)

between the Côte-Vertu and Bonaventure stations

Toward the Montmorency station

- Line 26 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency station² (±40 min)

- Line 903 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency station² (±55 min)

SERVICE MAINTAINED



OFF-PEAK AND WEEKENDS

- Line 26 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency terminal² (±30 min)

- Line 903 from the Sainte-Dorothée station to the Montmorency terminal² (±50 min)

- Shared taxibus line T26 with a transfer to line 26 (±35 min)

²⁻ The orange line is very busy between the Montmorency and Berri-UQAM stations. Users are encouraged to choose another route.






