* Stops from Grand-Moulin station were temporarily moved on chemin d'Oka, near Holy Family church for departures and near Saint-Agapit church for return trips. On weekdays, the route is served by minibuses and links Grand-Moulin and Deux-Montagnes stations. On weekends, Shuttle 404 serves both stations. Shuttle 404 service is available from 4:55 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. on weekdays, from 6:30 a.m. to 12:30 a.m. on Saturday, and from 7:30 a.m. to 11:35 p.m. on Sunday. Please note that the shuttle route ends at the Downtown terminal on weekends. The route goes along the shoulders of autoroute 640 and autoroute 13, as well as along the autoroute 20 reserved lane.
